


## Neighbourhood Watch Newsletter

#### **ENGRAVERS**

There are 6 engravers available for use by members of Neighbourhood Watch. They are for you to mark your property - microwaves, TV, video, power tools, etc. Any items made of wood, plastic or metal.

The code used is the initial of the given and surname (eg: for Mary Smith it would be MS); your birth date and state. An example of the code would be MS040761Q.

It is very important that a are household keeps an engraver for the least amount of time possible so that others are able to access it - 1 or 2 days should be sufficient - then pass it on quickly please.

Details should then be recorded on the Property Tracking System form provided with your Householders' Guide.

#### SIGNS

Large signs are to be erected at strategic points signalling to those who enter our area that this is indeed an operational Neighbourhood Watch Area.

Before this can occur, there must be evidence of 75% of plaques on letter boxes or fences. If you haven't attached yours so far, please do it <u>now</u>.

IF YOU NEED HELP, ASK YOUR BLOCK CO-ORDINATOR FOR ASSISTANCE.

#### **SECURITY**

In each newsletter there will be an item about some aspect of Security. This is to make you more aware of potential dangers and then be better prepared to deal with them.

Think about how best to protect your house as a whole. Burglars go for the easiest option. So if they have to make a lot of noise, take a lot of time and risk being seen, chances are they won't bother.

All points of entry into your home need to be strong and properly secured

The more difficult it is to break in, the less likely it is that someone will try.

Good security isn't only about having the latest locks and systems, it's about using them.

Change your daily patterns so that locking up and keeping your home secure becomes second nature to you and your family.

Keep plants trimmed low - no need to provide an intruder with a hiding place.

Regularly check the range of new security products available.
